## ORDINANCE: Amend Chapter 13 of the General Code of Winnebago County (Livestock Waste Management)

## TO THE WINNEBAGO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:

WHEREAS, it is well documented and widely recognized that nutrients and organic matter from mismanaged or misapplied livestock waste contributes to water quality degradation in the streams, rivers and lakes throughout Wisconsin, including those in Winnebago County; and

**WHEREAS,** the degradation of the water resources in Winnebago County poses a threat to the environment, health and economic welfare of the citizens of the county; and

WHEREAS, the Winnebago County Land Conservation Committee and Land and Water Conservation Department, in an effort to further protect the water resources of Winnebago County, must periodically revise and update referenced State Statutes, technical standards, definitions, and other wording within the Winnebago County Livestock Waste Management Ordinance (Chapter 13 of the Winnebago County General Code); and

**WHEREAS**, to provide uniformity with other Chapters of the General Code of Winnebago County and to identify a separate Chapter 13 Permit Fee Schedule.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors, that effective January 1, 2012, Section 13.11of Chapter 13 of the General Code of Winnebago County be amended to read as follows:
