RESOLUTION: Request U.S. Congress to Maintain

Oshkosh Facility for Processing Mail Originating in the 549 Zip Code Area

## TO THE WINNEBAGO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:

**WHEREAS**, the United States Postal Service is currently conducting a study as to the feasibility of moving mail processing operations for the 549 area zip code from Oshkosh to Green Bay; and

**WHEREAS**, the Personnel and Finance Committee of the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors is concerned as to the possible degradation of mail service within Winnebago County as a result of such transfer; and

**WHEREAS**, moving such operations to the Green Bay processing center does not appear to make good logistical sense, in that much of the mail from the area travels to Milwaukee and Chicago on route to other destinations, thus resulting in mail from cities such as Oshkosh and Appleton being routed to the Green Bay and then once again being routed through Oshkosh on its way to Milwaukee and other destinations; and

**WHEREAS,** the Oshkosh mail processing facility has expansion capabilities, which include possibly 30,000 square feet for immediate use and the ability to add another 250,000 square foot expansion to its current building if needed; and

**WHEREAS**, the Oshkosh processing facility is presently in the midst of a 1.2 million dollar upgrade to its lighting and its electrical services; and

**WHEREAS**, the present postal service study has failed to identify other sources of savings which might better serve the public; and

**WHEREAS**, consolidation of the 549 zip code area mail processing center in Green Bay would result in the loss of approximately 100 well-paying jobs in the Oshkosh area; and

**WHEREAS**, your undersigned Committee does not believe that the transfer of the Oshkosh postal processing operations to Green Bay would be in the best interest of Winnebago County.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors that it formally requests that the U.S. Postal Service maintain the Oshkosh Post Office as the processing center for outgoing mail in the 549 zip code area.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors that it hereby requests that the U.S. Congress intervene in relationship to this proposal until a government accounting office investigation can be conducted concerning the increased cost of transportation and the effect upon delivery standards for those communities now served by the Oshkosh area processing center.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors that a copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the Office of U.S. Congressman Thomas Petri, U.S. Congressman Steven Kagan, U.S. Senator Russell Feingold, U.S. Senator Herbert Kohl, and to the Office of the Lakeland District Manager and the Lakeland District Lead Plant Manager of the U.S. Postal Service, as well as the Post Master General.
