5 **County (Provision of Alcohol to**

8 **TO THE WINNEBAGO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:**

10 **NOW, THEREFORE,** the County Board of Supervisors of the County of
11 Winnebago does ordain as follows:
12

13 Create Section 9.31 of the General Code of Winnebago County (Provision
14 of Alcohol to Underage Persons)
15

16 **9.31 AUTHORITY.** (1) This Authority is adopted pursuant to that
17 authority provided by Section 125.10, Wisconsin Statutes.
18

19 (2) **SECTION 125.07(1) INCORPORATED BY REFERENCE.** Section
20 125.07(1), Wisconsin Statutes, to the extent such statutory section requires any
21 act to be performed or prohibits any act, is hereby adopted and by reference
22 made a part of this Section of the Code as fully set forth herein. Any act required
23 to be performed or prohibited by Section 125.07(1), is required or prohibited by
24 this Section of the Code.
25

26 (3) **DEFINITIONS.** That pursuant to that authority provided to
27 municipalities under Section 125.10, Stats., the definition of "premises" as
28 contained in Section 125.02(14)(m), Stats., shall be amended for the purpose of
29 this ordinance so as to include all public or private property, regardless of
30 whether said property is described in a license or permit.

32 (4) **PENALTY.** Any person who violates any provision of this Section
33 of the Code shall be subject to those forfeitures as specified in Section
34 125.07(1)(b), Wisconsin Statutes, which is incorporated herein by reference.
35

36 (5) **APPLICABILITY.** The provisions of this Ordinance shall apply in
37 all unincorporated areas in Winnebago County.
