Any act required 22 to be performed or prohibited by Section 125.07(1), is required or prohibited by 23 this Section of the Code. 24 25 (3) DEFINITIONS. That pursuant to that authority provided to 26 municipalities under Section 125.10, Stats., the definition of "premises" as 27 contained in Section 125.02(14)(m), Stats., shall be amended for the purpose of 28 this ordinance so as to include all public or private property, regardless of 29 whether said property is described in a license or permit. 30 31 (4) **PENALTY.** Any person who violates any provision of this Section 32 of the Code shall be subject to those forfeitures as specified in Section 33 125.07(1)(b), Wisconsin Statutes, which is incorporated herein by reference. 34 35 36 (5) **APPLICABILITY.** The provisions of this Ordinance shall apply in all unincorporated areas in Winnebago County. 37 38 39 40 41 42 43 44 45 46
