9	WHEREAS, dictation equipment throughout Winnebago County is becoming old
10	and obsolete and parts for equipment are difficult to find; and
11	WHEREAS, the Human Services department often has to send tapes through
12	the interoffice mail to get them from the Neenah office to the Oshkosh offices for
13	transcription which poses confidentiality risks; and
14	WHEREAS, a central dictation system allows users to dictate using phones or
15	hand held devices which can be put on a docking station and the information is quickly
16	transferred to a network storage device where transcription can quickly take place; and
17	WHEREAS, a central system eliminates most of the potential risk of loss of
18	confidentiality; and
19	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Winnebago County Board of
20	Supervisors that it hereby appropriates \$88,000 to a project to replace current dictation
21	equipment with a central dictation system.
22	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that funds to pay for a central dictation system be
23	transferred from the General Fund of Winnebago County to a Capital Project fund to
24	purchase and install a central dictation system with the General Fund being reimbursed
25	from a subsequent bond issue.

27	<i>Fiscal note:</i> The annual cost for hardware and software maintenance on a
28	central dictation system would run roughly \$9,300 per year.
