8 **TO THE WINNEBAGO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:**

10 **WHEREAS**, the Federal Highway Administration has designated April 19, 2010 through  
11 April 23, 2010 as National Work Zone Safety Awareness Week; and

13 **WHEREAS**, in a typical year, over one thousand people are killed in work zones  
14 nationwide, either as drivers, passengers or pedestrians; and  
15

16 **WHEREAS**, in the past few years Wisconsin work zones have averaged approximately  
17 1,200 accidents annually with an average of 15 fatalities per year; and  
18

19 **WHEREAS**, Marc Neumeyer and Dan Melhorn, employees of the Winnebago County  
20 Highway Department were fatally injured on March 7, 2006 while working in a work zone on USH  
21 41; and

23 **WHEREAS**, Workzone Safety Awareness Week in Winnebago County will again be  
24 dedicated to the memory of Marc Neumeyer and Dan Melhorn in 2010.

26 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors  
27 that the week of April 19, 2010 through April 23, 2010 is designated "Work Zone Safety  
28 Awareness Week" in Winnebago County.
