Meeting called to order by Chairman Kline at 1:34 pm.

1. <u>Approve extension of August, 2005 Industrial Development Board loan to City of</u> Menasha for two year period.

Stan Kline reported that the County Board at their June meeting approved resolutions, first, to appropriate \$500,000 to the IDB Revolving Loan fund for future loans, secondly, to loan \$1 million to the IDB for a two year period , and third, to approve the extension of Menasha's \$1.3 million loan for two years. Jerry Bougie distributed a handout detailing the revised loan status report with the new changes reflected for reference. It was discussed that the loan extension to Menasha would be based on a 15 year amortization at 3.25% interest (monthly interest and principal payments) with the outstanding loan balance to be paid in full after two years (August 2012). Discussion pursued. Dave Albrecht made a motion to approve the \$1.3 million loan extension to Menasha based on the terms indicated. Motion seconded by Ken Robl. Motion approved 9-0.

2. <u>Authorize payment of outstanding loan balance to Winnebago County Solid Waste</u> <u>Board with regard to 2005 loan.</u>

Stan Kline mentioned that paying off the \$1.3 million to Solid Waste would make the Solid Waste Board whole again in regard to the Menasha loan. Ken Robl made a motion to approve the payment of \$1.3 million from IDB Revolving Loan funds to pay off the debt to the Solid Waste Board in regard to the Menasha loan. Motion seconded by Kathy Lennon. Motion passed 9-0.

Motion by Dave Albrecht, seconded by Kathy Lennon to adjourn. Motion passed 9-0. Meeting adjourned at 1:42 pm.
