Committee briefly discussed how extraction sites are located and the shifting of authority if the Town of Winchester drops out of county zoning. Findings for denial are as follows: 1) The town denied the conditional use permit. 2) There were objections raised at the public hearing. Motion carried 3-2.

MOTION by T. Egan, seconded by J. Sievert, to adjourn decision to next deliberative in order to obtain the town's response. Motion carried 5-0.

6. <u>Harve Ross – Conditional Use</u>

Committee reviewed the findings in order to take action on a conditional use permit for a telecommunications tower. Zoning Administrator stated that the zoning office had not yet received any response from the town.

MOTION by T. Egan, seconded by C. Thompson, to adjourn decision to next deliberative in order to obtain the town's response. Motion carried 5-0.
