A decision was made on the following variance request:

<u>Ernest Anthes – Town of Oshkosh</u>. After discussion, a motion was made by G. Kargus to approve the variance request as follows: a 19 ft. setback from the new right-of-way line; a total of 23 ft. for side yard setbacks with no one side less than 10 ft., a 60 ft. setback for the house structure with a 10 ft. deep at-grade patio, resulting in a 50 ft. total shore yard setback. The motion included a condition that both lots be combined into one by certified survey map. Motion seconded by A. Schroeder.

G. Kargus read the findings. There were no questions on the findings and a roll-call vote followed:

That being the only variance request on the agenda, the Board then addressed the Temporary Use request of an art show for Michael Frank, Town of Omro, to be held October 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup>, 2009. Motion to approve by D. Mingus; seconded by G. Kargus; carried by voice vote.
