
Winnebago County Specialized Transportation Study Summit

The Winnebago County Aging and Disability Resource Center (ADRC), GO Transit, in the City of Oshkosh, and the East Central Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission conducted a specialized transportation study through a grant from the Wisconsin Department of Transportation. The study examined specialized transportation gaps, needs and barriers throughout Winnebago County. For a number of Winnebago County residents, especially elderly, low income, and disabled individuals, access to transportation for medical appointments, employment, education, and social events etc. is a major issue.

Interviews and surveys were used to gather input from the transportation providers, drivers, the users and local business and agencies that utilize the specialized transportation system for their patrons to identify the gaps, needs and barriers within the system. The evaluation of the specialized transportation system, including recommendations, will be showcased at the Winnebago County Specialized Transportation Study Summit in which key stakeholders, area decision makers, consumers, and the public are all invited to attend and comment.
