## 2. Siren Report

A brief overview of the outdoor warning sirens.

- The Town of Clayton property where the town siren is located has been fenced in by the town for security reasons and Emergency Management was given a key.
- The new portable siren was used at County USA this year. Two portable radios were included with the purchase.
- A new siren will be added next year in the Town of Vinland; possibly at the town hall. Also, Emergency Management may be looking at purchasing a second new siren next year; location to be determined.

## 3. Winnebago County Public-Private Partnership (PPP)

- The 2011 season ended with a successful tabletop exercise with three facilities (Aurora Medical Center, JJ Keller and Plexus) testing their emergency plans.
- An informational flyer was sent to all businesses through the chamber membership mailing list. The mailing, along with some website enhancements, was paid for through an OJA Grant.
- Linda L., along with another Winnebago County PPP member, went to Madison last month to hear about what direction the Partnerships in Wisconsin are taking.

## 4. Exercises

• EAA "Severe Storm Event" tabletop exercise has held at EAA on June 28<sup>th</sup>. Very successful planning exercise for all involved.

# 5. Ingestion Zone

- Linda K. handed out an ingestion zone map showing the very small portion where Winnebago County actually is included in the plan.
- Winnebago County Emergency Management has participated in some ingestion zone planning; however it is highly unlikely any release would affect our county. The immediate response would be media related, with public health taking the lead.
