- EAA experienced large wind gusts at this year's convention, however no weather problems reported. The new portable siren was on site and EAA already requested the portable siren for next year's event.
- EAA is now a "Storm Ready" event. To achieve this recognition, the EAA worked with the NWS Green Bay Office and Winnebago County Emergency Management to ensure severe weather safety procedures and methods to communicate weather information are in place during the yearly convention.
