3. Outdoor Warning Sirens

All Winnebago County sirens are sounded for three-minutes during the Saturday noon siren testing throughout the summer.

The portable outdoor warning siren has been stationed at Country USA, Rock USA and now is at the EAA grounds.

The siren located at Leonards Point Road and Sunkist Road will possibly be moved to another location due to the fact it is on private property and permission must be given before siren work is done each time.

4. <u>Emergency Operations Plan (EOP) change</u>

The Annex format that has been utilized in the Emergency Operations Plan has now switched over to an Emergency Support Function (ESF) system. The State of Wisconsin gave each county the latitude to choose which format they wanted to use. Winnebago County

Emergency Management has chosen the ESF format which is a more streamlined and concise document design.

A newly created Communications Plan for EAA will not be included in the ESF's. This plan will remain in the Emergency Management Office.

5. **Budget discussion**

The Emergency Management 2013 Budget is complete and is \$1,500 under last year's budget numbers. The Program Assistant will do 6.50 less hours per week which in turn will be added to the Deputy Director's position.

The budget meeting with the County Executive is scheduled for August 14th.
