SUBJECT MATTER OF THE MEETING

The Judiciary & Public Safety Committee has been invited to attend a meeting of local municipal police and fire department chiefs for Motorola's demonstration of the radio system project. The demonstration will be followed by a question and answer period.

Motorola gave a demonstration on the radio and paging overlay system after which the group asked questions and held discussions. Sheriff Matz advised that all radio orders are being done through the Sheriff's Office and all orders are due by November 15, 2011. Sheriff Matz further advised that it will be each agency's responsibility to maintain the radios and pay for subscriber unit maintenance starting in 2016. The group was advised of the new CCW (Carry Conceal Weapon) laws.
