Motion (Green Lake/FdL) to approve the treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried.

f) 2014 Elections to LWCB

Baneck explained that those elected in March of 2014 will take their seat in February of 2015 due to dates set by WI Statute. Each area needs to select a nominee by January 31st. Seats will be filled from the pool put forth by each area association. Jim VandenBrook stated that an area alternate is not needed.

Joe Piechowski was nominated (Winnebago/Waushara). A call for other nominees followed.

A unanimous ballot **(Waushara/ Winnebago)** was cast for Joe Piechowski to represent LWLWCA as their nominee in the upcoming election at the annual conference.

g) WLWCA 2013 Area Contribution - \$500.00

Baneck stated that only 2 areas contributed to this fund in 2013. VandenBrook recommended that area associations not contribute for 2014 because the state association will cover the cost

h) AFFILIATE AGENCY REPORTS

- Great Lakes Nonpoint Abatement Coalition Report (GLNAC) Greg Baneck reported that GLNAC had been approved as a committee to WLWCA and the issue would be resolved at the March business meeting. A portion of the GLNAC funds would remain in the new GLNAC committee and a portion would go to the WLWCA general fund.
- Wisconsin Land & Water Conservation Board (LWCB) Joe Piechowski reported approving county LWRM plans at the October meeting. LWCB is working on future schedules for LWRM plan approvals. The February meeting will approve more plans, discuss the Joint Allocation and elect new officers.
- 3. Wisconsin Land & Water Conservation Assoc (WLWCA) Baneck reported that the WLWCA board approved the strategic plan and GLNAC addition in December. Baneck explained AB 680 that would allow buying and trading of phosphorus credits and adaptive management. Also explained the option that would allow direct, pay per pound, payments to LWCD's to reduce phosphorus. This would allow treatment facilities to buy time until technology could catch up with their required upgrades. These payments could be 35% for staffing and 65% for cost sharing. VandenBrook added that the bill was well received in Madison on 1/30 and expects a senate version next week. EPA must agree with the bill's methods and issue approval. Treatment facilities would need a DOA variance to participate. Monitoring would be DNR's responsibility and the LWCB was suggested for oversight. Price would be \$50/lb of P and counties within the watershed could opt in/out of receiving the money. Farm Bureau has taken no position and the WI Corngrowers Assn has come out against the bill.

VandenBrook explained AB 679 on groundwater which is a reaction to the Lake Beulah case. The bill may affect DNR's ability to manage groundwater. Additionally town police powers may come into play on this issue.

4. Other Agencies – Glacierland RC&D – Tom Davies reported that Winnebago, Fond du Lac and Outagamie are using Glacierland as an AIS coordinator. The Winnebago System is now fully covered for AIS between Golden Sands and Glacierland RC&D's.
