Business Items:

Review and Approve/Disapprove the Winnebago System- Lake Planning Grant Application Authorization Resolution

Chairman Farrey opened the discussion by asking Julie Schmelzer to explain the purpose of the Grant and to answer questions regarding the application. Following her presentation Schmelzer addressed multiple questions and comments from the LCC and Mr. Albrecht. Chairman Farrey then asked Mr. Harris for his comments. Chairman Farrey then asked each LCC member and additional attendees if they had any other comments or questions on the item. Following final comments, Chairman Farrey asked if anyone wanted to move on the item. An Englebert/Barker motion to approve the amended resolution and send it to County Board, subject to Mr. Harris's approval of the Grant Application, was withdrawn following discussion and a suggestion to table the item until more information regarding the partnering Counties' positions on the matter could be acquired. A Bohn/Stokes motion to table the item failed to pass 3-4 (Neubauer, Snider, Englebert and Barker opposed). An Englebert/Barker motion to approve the amended resolution and send it to County Board, subject to Mr. Harris's approval of the Grant Application, was reintroduced and failed to pass 3-4 (Neubauer, Stokes, Bohn and Farrey opposed).
