PRESENT: Supervisors, Thomas Egan, Chairman, Claud Thompson, Larry Kriescher, Maribeth Gabert and Robert Keller. Cary Rowe, Zoning Administrator. Karen Fredrick, court reporter, Guest present.

The meeting was called to order by Thomas Egan, Chairman at 6:30 P.M. Committee members introduced themselves and Zoning Administrator explained appeals procedure and stated that protests for rezoning must be made 24 hours prior to the County Board meeting.

1. Scott & Kristi Jones – 2180 N Clay Rd, Town of Nekimi – Conditional Use

Applicant is requesting a conditional use to construct an unconcealed telecommunication facility. Guy Stewart (Applicant) - 3703 N Point Dr, Stevens Point was sworn in. Mr. Stewart stated that Verizon Wireless had a temporary facility on the south side of the road and the company wants to put up a permanent facility. Mr. Stewart added that the cell tower also had a lightning rod and would meet the airport height limitations. Mr. Stewart believed the maximum height was 57-ft but assured committee tower would not exceed the height limitations including the lightning rod. Mr. Stewart stated that there would be a security fence around the tower and collocation on the tower will be possible. Zoning Administrator stated that the Town Board of Nekimi approved the conditional use request. There was no additional testimony and this portion of the hearing was closed.
