 <u>Demolition of Old Buildings</u> - Mike reported that due to the lowest bidder for the demolition of the two old buildings not being able to meet their contractual agreement, the job has been awarded to the next lowest bidder. Demolition should begin within 10-14 days. The process will take approximately four months from start to finish.

The Master Gardeners have reiterated their concern that the gardens near both demolition sites, which include the vegetable and flower gardens as well as the arborvitae behind the Rehab Pavilion that have been built up over decades, be protected during the demolition process. They have been assured that every precaution will be taken in preserving the gardens.

• New Addition – The architect's latest drawings were received and they will be going out for bids soon. The committee viewed the latest drawings.
