Article addressed several steps that failed to stop the incident:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Friends & community at bar did not cut her off from alcohol 2) Safe ride vouchers were out at the bar 3) Friends said they didn't want to ride with her but didn't have another way home. <p>How do we prevent outcomes like this? Is there something we can do to educate or work with local taverns to have a triple check system similar to pre-surgical checks in a hospital?</p>
