- 1. Call to Order: P. O'Brien called the meeting to order at 9:01 a.m.
- 2. <u>Approve Agenda:</u> Motion to approve the June 3, 2015 agenda, made by K. Robl and seconded by G. Konrad. Motion carried 7-0.
- 3. Public Comments on Agenda Items: None.
- 4. <u>Announcement/Communications:</u> J. Rabe reminded the Solid Waste Management Board (SWMB) Members of the Tri-County Single Stream Recycling Facility Open House on Saturday, June 13, 2015, 9:00 a.m. Noon. J. Rabe explained that he will have a SWMB Meeting Agenda posted for the Open House due to the potential of a SWMB Member quorum in attendance.
 - J. Rabe notified the SWMB that a Wi-Fi internet server will soon be installed in the SWMB Meeting Room for use by Board Members.

- 5. <u>Approval of Minutes May 20, 2015 Open Session:</u> Motion to approve the May 20, 2015 open session minutes, made by K. Robl and seconded by S. Locke. Motion carried 7-0.
- 6. <u>Discussion Engine #4 Repair Update:</u> J. Rabe presented the SWMB with the following Engine #4 Repair Update.
 - The last Engine #4 Repair Update was presented to the SWMB on May 20, 2015.
 - The shortblock arrived at Inland Power Group from Austria on May 26, 2015.
 - The shortblock swap-out took place on May 29, 2015.
 - The target date for startup/commissioning is approximately June 12, 2015.
 - Engines #1, #2, #3 & #5 have been operating while Engine #4 is down; Maintenance Technicians will likely have to shut down an engine at Snell Road Landfill once Engine #4 comes back on-line.
 - The flare is used intermittently to control odors.

Discussion ensued amongst the SWMB.

7. <u>Discussion/Action – 2015 Retained Earnings Allocation:</u> J. Rabe presented the SWMB with the proposed 2015 Retained Earnings Reservation as follows:

- J. Rabe explained that the 2014 Financial Report showed a \$154,828 surplus in the retained earnings reservation fund (December 31 balance of \$24,654,828). The 2015 Budget plans for operational costs similar to 2014 with a small decrease of the estimated retained earnings balance.
- J. Rabe suggested that the following fund goal changes could be made to meet future needs:
 - Increase "Future Landfill Airspace Development" from \$3,100,000 to \$4,000,000.
 - Decrease "Debt Service Recycling" from \$1,700,000 to \$1,400,000.
 - Decrease "Surplus for Future Solid Waste Transportation" from \$4,200,000 to \$3,600,000.
- J. Rabe explained that Foth Infrastructure and Environment (Foth) reviewed the 2015 Retained Earnings Allocation for suggested changes.

Discussion ensued amongst the SWMB members.

P. Eisen requested that further discussion and action on the 2015 Retained Earnings Allocation be considered after Agenda Item #9.

8. Closed Session:

- 10. <u>Future Agenda Items:</u> P. Eisen asked for an update on the SWMB Staff's findings for the use of SWMB Retained Earnings to fund Municipal Bonds.
- 11. <u>Set Next Meeting Date:</u> The next SWMB meeting date is scheduled for June 17, 2015 at 9:00 a.m.
