- Container Program customer surveys reveal an overall positive experience, competitive pricing, and growing use of the internet for container rental research.
- Two additional 20 cubic yard containers and six additional 4 cubic yard containers will be added to the inventory to help meet customer demand.
- Container lease customers remain in good standing.
