### **NEW BUSINESS**

Nelson-Presentation on USH 41 Corridor camera locations and capabilities.

Public may access through <u>511.wi.gov</u> which will provide still shots. Emergency responders have access through <u>transportal.cee.wisc.edu</u> for live continuous feed. Users will need to request access and once credentials approved will be able to utilize. Winnebago County Communications Center in the process of a live feed through fiber which they will be able to isolate cameras for continuous viewing.

Early stages of planning at this time time with design plans beginning 2014 and a projected start date of 2020. Roundabouts may be part of this project at intersections with CTH JJ, CTH G, and CTH GG.

#### Anthes- Fatalities were discussed.

 01-15-14 two vehicle crash on STH 76 at Joseph Peters. N/B vehicle lost control and crossed centerline and collided with S/B vehicle. Driver of N/B vehicle Amanda Prado was killed. Snow covered roadway, Too fast for conditions, and Failure to have control were factors.

- 2) 01-30-14 two vehicle crash on USH 45 South at Coronado. S/B vehicle lost control and crossed centerline and collided with N/B vehicle. Driver of S/B vehicle Gerardo Medina was killed. Snow covered roadway, Too fast for conditions, and Failure to have control were factors.
- 3) 02-20-14 two vehicle crash on STH 44 at Bonnieview. N/B vehicle crossed centerline and collided with S/B vehicle. Passenger in N/B vehicle Ann Knuth was killed. Left of center was factor.
- 4) 02-23-14 snowmobile vs. truck on Fairview Rd at the Friendship Trail in which the operator of the snowmobile Robert Schneider was killed. Failure to yield right away was factor.
- 5) 03-12-14 three vehicle crash at STH 76 at CTH G. N/B vehicle stopped at CTH G waiting to turn left was rearended by another N/B vehicle and was pushed into the path of a S/B vehicle. Driver of stopped N/B vehicle Richard Morton was killed.

## Panosh-

-Reported that 2014 fatalities are down Statewide when compared to a year ago. 2013 at this time last year had 108 reported traffic deaths while this year there have been 90 to date. There will not be any additional funding available for traffic grants in 2014, unsure of the funding available for next year.
