Jessica Beckendorf shared information on the work she is doing in Omro regarding downtown business development. Up-coming programs include work with the Plan Commission and a Civility Workshop.

Youth and Science: Leonard Polzin reviewed his work with afterschool programs, the three UW-Oshkosh interns supporting these efforts and National Youth Science Day. These programs focus on Science, Technology, Engineer and Math (STEM) or agriculture topics. Polzin is also working with Nick Schneider and the secondary Agriculture Educators in the county to increase knowledge/awareness of agriculture.

Horticulture: Kimberly Miller provided an up-date on Emerald Ash Borer – its presence in the county and efforts targeting its control. This work includes collaborating with DNR and municipalities regarding identification, treatment and disposal of wood. Currently there is no county plan for addressing the removal/disposal of infested wood or tree replacement.

Vice Committee Chair Report: Hegg asked that Kristi Cutts provide an up-date from the Agriculture newsletter on efforts targeting farm families on the Affordable Care Act at an up-coming meeting.
