Carolyn Beyer, 628 2nd Street, Menasha; spoke in support adding funds to provide a grant to REACH Counseling Services for a therapist that would work directly with Winnebago County residents.

COUNTY EXECUTIVE'S BUDGET PRESENTATION

Executive Mark Harris began his presentation with an overview of how the county's budget process works. The equalized tax rate for 2019 is the lowest it has been since the year 2000 at \$5.26. This is down \$.20 from last year.

Executive Harris explained that after these budget hearings, the county will use the approved budget to establish the equalized tax rate for 2019. He stated that the county can only increase the tax levy in 2019 by the percentage that our tax base—value of real estate in the county—has increased by net new construction in 2018.

Executive Harris said that there was a one-time large reduction in worker's compensation insurance throughout the departments. The reserve was used to reduce worker's compensation chargebacks to departments. This may be a one-time reduction for this account. Executive Harris explained that this budget has a lot of reserves applied in it.

Executive Harris stated that based on figures in the proposed budget property owners will probably see very little change to their 2019 county tax rate.

Executive Harris then began his presentation of his 2019 budget.
