7	WHEREAS, Winnebago County is a qualified political subdivision of the State of Wisconsin; and
8	WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Workers' Compensation Act ("Act") provides that an employer covered by the Act
9	either insure its liability with a workers' compensation insurance carrier authorized to do business in Wisconsin, or be
10	exempted (self-insured) from insuring liabilities with a carrier and, thereby, assume the responsibility for its own
11	workers' compensation risk and payment; and
12	WHEREAS, the State of Wisconsin and its political subdivisions may self-insure workers' compensation
13	without a special order from the Department of Workforce Development ("Department") if they agree to report
14	faithfully all compensable injuries and agree to comply with the Act and rules of the Department; and
15	WHEREAS, at its January 8, 2015, meeting, your undersigned Committee approved the continuation of the
16	self-insured Workers' Compensation Program for Winnebago County in compliance with DWD 80.60(3), Wisconsin
17	Administrative Code.
18 19	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors that it hereby
20	authorizes as follows:
21	1) That the self-insured Workers' Compensation Program that is currently in effect for Winnebago County
22	be continued; and
23	2) That the Winnebago County Clerk forward a certified copy of this Resolution to the Workers'
24	Compensation Division of the Wisconsin Department of Workforce Development.
