WINNEBAGO COUNTY ACCEPTANCE OF TOWN ZONING ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, Winnebago County has adopted a comprehensive revision to its county zoning ordinance pursuant to Wis. Stats. 59.69(5)(d); and

WHEREAS, the Town of Menasha has notified the County that the Town will not approve the comprehensive revision and desires to adopt a Town Zoning Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, upon the failure by the Town to approve the comprehensive revision, and upon the expiration of one year following the County comprehensive revision, the Town has authority to adopt a Town-wide Ordinance pursuant to Wis. Stats. 60.62(3) after said Ordinance has been approved by the County; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Menasha has adopted villages powers; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Menasha has prepared a local Town-wide Zoning Ordinance for adoption; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Menasha has held the required public hearings before the Town Planning Commission and Town Board on the proposed Zoning Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Town of Menasha Board of Supervisors hereby approves the proposed Town Zoning Ordinance as to form and declares its intent to adopt the proposed Ordinance after approval by the County Board.

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Town of Menasha Board of Supervisors that the Town of Menasha requests that the Winnebago County Board pass a resolution approving the Town of Menasha Zoning Ordinance, thereby allowing the adoption by the Town Board of the County Board approved Town of Menasha Zoning Ordinance.
