6	TO THE WINNEBAGO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:
7	WHEREAS, Sequoia Consulting has been preparing a Cost Allocation Plan for Winnebago County for
8	several years; and
9	WHEREAS, Winnebago County is able to capture large sums of federal and state funds to reimburse the
10	County for indirect costs allocated as a result of the Cost Allocation Plan; and
11	WHEREAS, Sequoia Consulting is willing to hold the price constant at \$5,600 per year for the next three
12	years, which is equal to the price Sequoia charged the County for the past three years; and
13	WHEREAS, in prior years Winnebago County contacted other agencies to draft the Plan, but all were
14	considerably more expensive; and
15	WHEREAS, this project requires specialized knowledge and understanding of rules related to recoverable
16	costs; and
17	WHEREAS, the Finance Department does not have any staff members that have the time to acquire the
18	knowledge to do this report in house.
19 20	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors that it hereby
21	authorizes the Finance Department to contract with Sequoia Consulting to manage a Cost Allocation Plan for 2015,
22	2016, and 2017 at a cost of \$5,600 per year.
23	
24	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors that the Finance Departmen
25	shall include this amount in each annual budget to cover such cost.
26 27	Fiscal Note: The annual fee of \$5,600 per year, is the same price Winnebago County paid for the past three years
28	Sequoia is willing to continue to manage the plan without any price increase.
