2 3 4 5	RESOLUTION: Amend Section 2(a) of the Merit Pay Plan to Allow the Winnebago County Executive to Budget an Estimated Increase in Each Departments' Budget Rather Than Placing the Entire Amount in a Separate Account.
6	TO THE WINNEBAGO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:
7	WHEREAS, at its May 19, 2015, County Board Meeting, the Winnebago County Board adopted a Merit Pay
8	Plan; and
9	WHEREAS, Section 2(a) of the Merit Pay Plan states that the entire amount of merit pay being proposed in
10	the County Executive's Budget "will be budgeted in a separate contingency account" as indicated below:
11	Section 2: Establishment of Merit Pool
12	(a) As part of the County budget process, the County Executive will include in the Executive Budget an
13	amount designated for merit pay increases County-wide. This amount will be budgeted in a separate
14	contingency account, not a part of operating department budgets;
15	and
16	WHEREAS, the Budget Book includes an overview section that summarizes the budget in many different
17	ways including the following:
18	expenditures by division
19	where funds go
20	levy by division
21	 financial comparisons between years by account type, and
22	 several other ways; and
23	WHEREAS, these schedules summarizing Winnebago County's budget will not be very meaningful if they do
24	not reflect a best estimate of departments' budgets; and
25	WHEREAS, some of the departments are "special apportionments," and funds for pay increases should be
26	reflected there so the apportionments are accurate; and
27	WHEREAS, although amounts will be included in departments' budgets, pay increases are not automatic—
28	pay increases are still dependent on performance reviews as part of the Merit Pay Plan; and
29 20	WHEREAS, to keep departments' budgets comparable between years, it is important to make this change
30 31	now so it can be reflected in the 2016 Budget.
31 32	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors that it hereby
33	amends Section 2(a) of the Merit Pay Plan to read as follows: "The Winnebago County Executive shall include in
34	each departments' budget an estimate of the amount of pay increases that will affect each department."
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36	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors that subsequent budget
37	adjustments may be brought before the Board, if necessary, if the amount of the merit pay adjustment to individual
38	departments exceeds the amount included in the budget, as long as the total amount of merit pay increase does not
39	exceed the amount adopted as part of the annual county budget.
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41	Fiscal Impact: There is no fiscal impact to this Resolution. It merely changes how estimated labor cost increases
42	will be presented in the annual budget document.
