RESOLUTION: Appropriate \$3 Million to an Airport Ramp Reconstruction Project to be funded by \$2,925,000.00 State and Federal AIP Funds and by \$75,000.00 from Airport Fund Balance

## TO THE WINNEBAGO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:

**WHEREAS**, the Winnebago County 5-year Capital Improvements Plan includes a project to reconstruct airport terminal and Fixed Base Operator (FBO) ramps to be completed over a 3-year period beginning in 2011; and

**WHEREAS**, the estimated cost of the project is \$3 million with approximate funding of roughly \$1 million per year; and

**WHEREAS**, Federal and State AIP (Airport Improvement Project) funds of \$2,925,000.00 may be available to fund most of the project, with the Airport Fund paying the balance of \$75,000.00 out of the Airport Fund balance; and

WHEREAS, the project will not proceed until the Federal and State funds are awarded; and

**WHEREAS**, in order for the process to proceed for funding approval, the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors must pass a resolution approving the project contingent upon receipt of Federal and State funding.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors that it hereby appropriates \$3 million for an Airport Ramp Reconstruction Project to be funded by \$2,925,000.00 from State and Federal AIP funds, with the \$75,000.00 balance coming from the Airport Fund balance.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors that approval of this project is contingent on the Federal and State funds being awarded as described above.

**Fiscal Note**: This will reduce the Airport Fund balance by \$75,000.00. The Airport Fund balance as of the 2010 audit is \$2,008,923.00
