ORDINANCE: Create Section 9.30 of the General Code of Winnebago County: Authorize Charges for

**Unnecessary Rescue Efforts** 

## TO THE WINNEBAGO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:

**WHEREAS**, there have been a number of incidents in recent years wherein the Winnebago County Sheriff has initiated rescue efforts regarding the abandonment of motor vehicles, boats, watercraft, snowmobiles, or all terrain vehicles discovered on the waterways of Winnebago County, only later to learn that such rescue efforts were unnecessary and precipitated by a failure of the owners or occupants to notify the Winnebago County Sheriff's Department, in a timely manner, that the occupants had exited the vehicle, boat, watercraft, snowmobile, or all terrain vehicle and found safe shelter; and

**WHEREAS**, the Judiciary and Public Safety Committee of the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors hereby recommends the adoption of an Ordinance authorizing the Winnebago County Sheriff's Department to bill the owners or occupants of said motor vehicles, boats, watercraft, snowmobiles, or all terrain vehicles for the cost of such unnecessary rescue attempts so as to deter individuals from failing to notify the Winnebago County Sheriff's Department in a timely manner that such rescue efforts are unnecessary.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors that Section 9.30 of the General Code of Winnebago County is hereby adopted so as to read as follows:

## 9.30 <u>AUTHORIZE CHARGES FOR UNNECESSARY WATER RESCUE EFFORTS</u>

(1) The Winnebago County Sheriff is hereby authorized to charge any owner or occupant of an abandoned motor vehicle, boat, watercraft, snowmobile, or all terrain vehicle, discovered on the waterways of Winnebago County, for the costs of any search and rescue effort precipitated by the owner's or occupant's failure to notify the Winnebago County Sheriff's Department in a timely manner that the owner or occupants have exited the vehicle, boat, watercraft, snowmobile, or all terrain vehicle and have found safe shelter. "Costs" shall include, but shall not be limited to, gross pay and benefits actually paid to Winnebago County Sheriff's Department personnel who participated in said search and rescue efforts; capital costs for the use of rescue and other vehicles and equipment; and fuel costs associated with said search and rescue efforts. Total costs billed regarding a single incident shall not exceed \$1,000.00 in aggregate.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** by the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors that said Ordinance shall take effect as of the date following the date of its publication.
