8 9	WHEREAS	, the Winnebago County Parks Department has operated public boat launches at the Black Wolf,
10	Osh-O-Nee, and As	sylum Point properties for many years; and
11	WHEREAS	, in 2013 Winnebago County sold 1,498 boat landing trailer parking stickers and approximately
12	15,792 daily permite	s that in turn generated \$132,510 in revenue, which is to be reinvested in the County Park
13	System, specifically	v, for boating facilities at the seven County-owned launch sites; and
14	WHEREAS	, over the past year, counties around Lake Winnebago worked together on Weigh-In on the
15	Winnebago, a multi	-governmental and private effort to reach out to the public around the Winnebago system on ways
16	to better take care of	of the system; and
17	WHEREAS	, the three big outcomes of the outreach effort are to address algae blooms, polluted runoff, and
18	invasive species, al	Il large scale issues requiring an extensive period of time and dollars to address; and
19	WHEREAS, a number of smaller but still important outcomes of the outreach effort include establishing a	
20	universal boat launch permit for public boat launches around Lake Winnebago; and	
21	WHEREAS, the counties of Calumet, Fond du Lac, and Winnebago have reached an agreement to establish	
22	a three-county annual boat landing trailer parking permit for 2014, which is essentially a boat launch permit that the	
23	three counties will sell in addition to the permit programs already established within each of the three counties; and	
24	WHEREAS, the three-county annual boat landing trailer parking permit will be sold by all three counties with	
25	the county issuing t	he permit retaining the proceeds of the permit sale.

48	Fiscal Note: This Ordinance does not require an appropriation from the County General Fund. It is extremely difficult		
49	to determine the fiscal impact of this new launch fee. It appears that there were 173 residents from		
50	Fond du Lac County and 4 residents from Calumet County who purchased a Winnebago County Boat		
51	Landing Parking Permit in 2013. Additionally, 15 residents from Winnebago County purchased a		
52	Fond du Lac County sticker, and Calumet County recorded no sticker purchases from Winnebago		
53	County residents in 2013. The impact on fee collections is unknown at this time. Staff and Committee		
54	members will evaluate the impact of this new launch fee at the end of the boating season and make a		
55	recommendation on an extension of elimination of the three-county season permit beyond 2014.
