RESOLUTION: Appropriate an Additional \$345,000 to the Project to Demolish the Old Park View Health Center Buildings and Fund with General Obligation Debt to be Issued Later in 2012

TO THE WINNEBAGO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:

WHEREAS, the old Park View Health Center facility was scheduled to be razed upon completion of the new facility; and

WHEREAS, the first step in the demolition project is to hire a vendor to remove asbestos from the old facility and properly dispose of it; and

WHEREAS, after completion of the asbestos removal, a second vendor was hired and has been working to raze the old facility buildings; and

WHEREAS, during the demolition process, additional asbestos was discovered that was not detected by the previous vendor because of its location; and

WHEREAS, discovery of this additional asbestos has resulted in project delays and will require additional funds to cover the cost of the delays and to remove and properly dispose of the additional asbestos; and

WHEREAS, it has been estimated that it will cost an additional \$345,000 to complete the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors that it hereby appropriates \$345,000 to the project to raze the old Park View Health Center facility.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors that the funds to pay for said project shall be transferred from Winnebago County's General Fund to the Capital Project to raze the old Park View Health Center's buildings with the General Fund being reimbursed from a subsequent bond issue.

Fiscal Note: Annual debt service on the \$345,000 will be approximately \$41,000 per year for a 10-year period.
