8 TO THE WINNEBAGO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:

10 WHEREAS, the Winnebago County Public Health Department has been awarded grant money for
11 administration of the Wisconsin Well Woman Program; and

13 WHEREAS, there is now a need for the creation of two (2) permanent grant-funded full-time Wisconsin Well
14 Woman Program Case Specialist positions in the Winnebago County Public Health Department; and

16 WHEREAS, this newly-entitled position will be included in Appendix A of the 2012 Winnebago County
17 Administrative Salary Plan as follows: Wisconsin Well Woman Program Case Specialist: Step A: \$19.20; Step B:
18 \$20.00; Step C: \$20.83; Step D: \$21.70; Step E: \$22.56; and Step F: \$23.46, and said positions will only exist as
19 long as grant funds are available to cover the cost for two full-time positions.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors that it hereby
23 authorizes the creation of two (2) permanent grant-funded full-time Wisconsin Well Woman Program Case Specialist
24 positions to be added to the Winnebago County Public Health Department.

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors that funds to cover the
28 cost of this new position be fully covered by grant monies.
