WHAT DO I DO WITH LATEX PAINT?



Latex paint can be disposed of with your regular trash when the paint is dry. If the paint is still liquid, open the top and allow the paint to air dry. To speed up the process, you may also add sand, kitty litter or latex paint hardener to the paint.
