Welcome to the Drug Abuse Resistance Education (D.A.R.E.) Program. You son/daughter is beginning an exciting program to help them resist pressures which may influence them to experiment with alcohol, tobacco, marijuana, inhalants and other drugs.

During class, we will discuss how these drugs can affect there body, as well as how to identify the pressures that others may place on them, Peer Pressure. They will be introduced to the D.A.R.E. Decision Making Model that will assist them in problem solving and help them to make wise decisions.

Complete a D.A.R.E. student workbook Have good attendance Demonstrate good behavior in class (In and Out of D.A.R.E.) Keep their body free from drugs Complete a D.A.R.E. project Make a pledge statement to make wise decisions about alcohol, tobacco and other drugs
