NEW BUSINESS

Panosh - Number of fatalities is at 81 compared to 102 last year. Two fatalities in Winnebago County. From mid May to mid September the police will be focusing on Highway 41 in Brown, Outagamie, Winnebago, and Fond du Lac counties.

McGrath - Questioned whether the primary enforcement of seat belts has resulted in a higher use of seatbelts.

Nelson - There will be more data on speed on the roads once the construction is complete.

Wilkinson - Neenah Police Department concerned about drunk driving. Trying to change the perception about chances of being caught.

Zimmerman - Two fatalities in this quarter.

2/20 - 16 year old female passenger was killed when their northbound vehicle crossed Highway 41 into the southbound lane. Alcohol was not a factor. Seat belts were in use.

3/19 - 31 year old female passenger was killed when their vehicle left the road on southbound Highway45, south of Oshkosh. Alcohol was a factor. No seat belts in use. 1:57 a.m.
