1. Call to order:

The DOT will sell it to the County for \$6,600; however, the DNR has designated that area as a wetland. If the County purchases the land, a parking lot could not be built on it. Parks staff recommends not purchasing the parcel. Committee asked the Town of Oshkosh if they would like Winnebago County to purchase this land. They would recommend that the town buys it. Committee discussed possibly purchasing the parcel and holding it for future developments.

Steve Binder made a motion not to purchase the remnant parcel adjacent to the WIOUWASH trail in the Town of Oshkosh and give the Town of Oshkosh the first option to buy it. Jim Ponzer seconded. Motion carried 3-0.
