 A McKnight's Long-Term Care news article was distributed for the Committee to read entitled, <u>Two More Wisconsin Nursing Homes Closing</u>, <u>Both Citing Medicaid Reimbursement</u> <u>Problems</u>. The article states that 16 nursing homes were closed in Wisconsin last year because of inadequate Medicaid reimbursements.
