


2023 Facility Condition Assessment

- The County hired McKinstry to review all the County buildings except for the Fox Cities campus
- A total of 113 buildings were assessed for their condition
- The process took about 4 months to complete
- The results of the assessment provided the following information:
 - The overall condition of the buildings
 - The overall condition of the building components
 - A schedule of outstanding and future repairs
 - An Opinion of Probable Cost for the repairs




Yearly Expenditures
