PLEASE TAKE NOTICE, that pursuant to Sec. 893.80, Wis. Stats, Wisconsin Public Service Corporation, 700 North Adams Street, Green Bay, Wisconsin by Bonnie Wesley, Claims Analyst, hereby gives notice that on or about January 18, 2019, the claimant suffered damage and associated loss of electric service in the area of Dawes Street and Algoma Boulevard in the City of Oshkosh, Wisconsin.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that at the aforementioned time and place, the claimant sustained damage to electric equipment as a result of the Winnebago County Highway department vehicle striking a 30' fiberglass pole.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE, that all times material Winnebago County through its officials, employees, agents or representatives, including but not limited to Winnebago County Highway Department, failed to observe the fiberglass pole and caused damage to the fiberglass pole and two 350 watt sodium lights when the pole was struck.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that the damages suffered by Wisconsin Public Service Corporation were directly and proximately caused by the actions of Winnebago County Highway Department in that its employee, in the normal course of employment, did strike and damage WPS fiberglass pole and associated equipment when struck by a salting truck.

Explanation Of Billing Terms

Usage

BTU (British Thermal Unit) – A factor that converts gas volumes into the heating value of the gas.

Budget Billing – Billing plan that spreads your energy costs evenly over the entire year, so you can avoid high seasonal bills.

CCF (100 Cubic Feet) – The volume of gas measured by your meter.

Degree Days – A measurement that reflects the effects of weather on your heating and cooling needs. Daily degree days are calculated by subtracting the average daily temperature from 65°F. Heating degree days result if temperatures are less than 65°F; cooling degree days if more than 65°F.

KWH (Kilowatt Hour) – A measurement of electric use that is used to calculate your charges. One KWH will light a 100-watt bulb for 10 hours.

Therms – A measurement of the heat energy in natural gas that is used to calculate your charges. For billing, it's the volume of natural gas in CCFs multiplied by the heat factor (BTU).

Charges

Daily Fixed Charge – A daily charge that helps cover the fixed costs of providing service to customers. This includes equipment, billing and programs.

Distribution Charge – The charge for the safe and reliable delivery of gas to customers.

Energy Charge – The cost for the actual amount of electricity used, measured in kilowatt-hours.

Fuel Cost Adjustment – A charge or credit that's applied when our actual cost to purchase natural gas is higher or lower than what was projected in your gas rates.

Gas Supply Acquisition Service – A charge for the purchase and management of gas supplies, including the carrying costs of purchasing supplies in the summer and storing until winter.

Gas Supply Service – The costs for providing natural gas to our customers. This includes Gas Supply Acquisition Service and Natural Gas Costs.

Local Distribution Service – The charge for the safe and reliable delivery of gas to customers. It includes a Daily Fixed Charge, Distribution Charge and Gas Supply Acquisition Service.

Natural Gas Costs – The actual cost of the natural gas used.

WI Low Income Assistance Fee – A fee required by state law that helps fund low-income assistance programs.
