9 26.1 Responsibilities of the County Board of Supervisors are defined by the 10 laws of the State of Wisconsin and the Rules of Order of the Winnebago 11 County Board of Supervisors. 12 13 26.2 County Supervisors are expected to individually contribute to a 14 collaborative effort to set a vision and strategic mission goals and make 15 broad policy decisions that support the strategic mission to advance the 16 priorities of the county. Examples of such activities, include, but are not limited to: 17 1. Participating in the process of debate and voting on proposed 18 19 ordinances, resolutions and motions in County Board and 20 Committee meetings; 21 2. Providing policy and direction to the management of the county 22 regarding delivery of county services while refraining from the 23 delivery, management or administration of daily operations of the 24 county: 25 3. Being responsive to the needs of their constituency through 26 effective communication; 27 4.
