10 **WHEREAS**, the Winnebago County Sheriff's Office was awarded an ALERT SWAT grant from the
11 Department of Homeland Security in the amount of \$15,250 in November 2021; and

12 **WHEREAS**, this grant was used to host the National Tactical Officer Association Commander 1 Course in
13 February 2022; and

14 **WHEREAS**, the funds from this grant were not carried over from 2021 to 2022; and

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors that it hereby
17 authorizes the Winnebago County Sheriff's Office to re-accept an ALERT SWAT grant from the State of Wisconsin
18 Emergency Management, Department of Homeland Security in the amount of \$15,250, and appropriate the funds to
19 for the SWAT Commander 1 course held in February 2022.

21 **FISCAL IMPACT:** The fiscal impact is \$15,250 in revenue from the State of Wisconsin.
