RESOLUTION: Approving \$324,500 from the Spirit Fund's Government Identified Community Projects Category to Upgrade the Winneconne Parks including Remodeling the Barn and Improving Boat Ramps and Piers, Fish Cleaning Stations, Larger Bulk Heads, Extended Parking in the Village of Winneconne

TO THE WINNEBAGO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:

WHEREAS, Lake Winneconne Park serves local and regional citizens through water usage, beach activities, baseball games, weddings, and overall enjoyment of beautiful water ways; and

WHEREAS, the site is used daily by residents outside of the Village of Winneconne; and

WHEREAS, the barn remodel in Lake Winneconne Park allows people to rent space that can be used for indoor or outdoor events; and

WHEREAS, the proceeds from the rent go to funding the Village of Winneconne park system budget; and WHEREAS, the barn remodel includes but is not limited to siding, ADA door access, windows, drywall, insolation, temperature control, and wiring, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Winneconne has received a \$250,000 grant from the Wisconsin DNR to complete upgrades to Lake Winneconne Park; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Winneconne has invested \$85,000 of its own budget; and

WHEREAS, the upgrade includes the improvement and addition of boat docks/piers, fish cleaning stations, larger bulk heads, extended parking and facility upgrades, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Winneconne completed Spirit Fund applications for both the Barn Remodel and Winneconne Parks improvements on-time, requesting \$315,000, and

WHEREAS, the ARPA Strategy and Outcomes Commission recommends a grant of \$315,000 from the Winnebago County Spirit Fund; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors that \$324,500 from the Spirit Fund's Government Identified Community Project category be approved to improve and add onto boat ramps and piers, fish cleaning stations, larger bulk heads, extended parking, and upgrades to Winneconne Parks in the Village of Winneconne.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors that upon completion of the project, the Village of Winneconne will submit supporting documentation to the Winnebago County Finance Director outlining the expenditures. The documentation will be submitted within 6 months of the completion of the project but not to exceed 5 years from date of disbursement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors that the Village of Winneconne shall be responsible for reimbursement to Winnebago County for any disbursed funds which are determined by Winnebago County to have been misused or misappropriated. Any reimbursement of funds which is required by Winnebago County shall be due within 45 days after giving written notice to recipient of such misuse or misappropriation.

Fiscal Note: This resolution will not amend the County Budget. \$324,500 will be authorized for use from the Spirit Fund.
