# RESOLUTION: Approving \$75,000 from the Spirit Fund's Government Identified Community Projects Category to NEW Mental Health Connection to Implement Innovative Features in the Service Directory and Update Technology and Website Content

- 9 WHEREAS, NEW Mental Health Connection provides online and easily accessible resources that enhance

- WHEREAS, NEW Mental Health Connection has seen usage and need skyrocket during and in the wake ofthe pandemic; and
- WHEREAS, with an average of 48 visits per day to the Men's Self-Care Toolkit, over 560 people have
  watched stories related to mental health issues among men in the previous reporting period; and
- WHEREAS, the Crisis Services page was accessed over 1500 times in 2020 and the number was doubled in2023.
- 18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors that \$75,000 from 19 the Spirit Fund's Government Identified Community Project category be approved to NEW Mental Health Connection to 20 implement innovative features in the Service Directory and update technology and website content for NEW Mental 21 Health Connection.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors that upon completion of the project, NEW Mental Health Connection will submit supporting documentation to the Winnebago County Finance Director outlining the expenditures. The documentation will be submitted within 6 months of the completion of the project but not to exceed 5 years from date of disbursement.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors that NEW Mental Health Connection shall be responsible for reimbursement to Winnebago County for any disbursed funds which are determined by Winnebago County to have been misused or misappropriated. Any reimbursement of funds which is required by Winnebago County shall be due within 45 days after giving written notice to recipient of such misuse or misappropriation.
- 31 Fiscal Note: This resolution will not amend the County Budget. \$75,000 will be authorized for use from the 32 Spirit Fund.

#### **Background**

Currently, jointly funded by ARPA money from the City of Appleton and Outagamie County, as well as grants through the Advancing a Healthier Wisconsin Endowment at the Medical College of Wisconsin and ThedaCare Community funds, NEW Mental Health Connection has seen usage and need skyrocket during and in the wake of the pandemic. With an average of 48 visits per day to the Men's Self-Care Toolkit, over 560 people have watched stories related to mental health issues among men in the previous reporting period. The Crisis Services page was accessed over 1500 times in 2020, and that has been steadily increasing to double that in 2023. The widely used, and successful development of the We Heart You App, resource for mobile phones, used ARPA funds from the City of Appleton and Outagamie County

#### Policy Discussion
