- Case numbers in Wisconsin continue to climb. It took 7.5 months to get to 100,000 cases but it only took 36 days to add another 100,000 cases. The ways things are going, it will only take another 20 days to reach another 100,000. The unnecessary death toll has climbed to more than 2,395 people.
- Positive cases appear to have leveled off at a very high level in the nine counties in our region. All counties are still in the Red Zone.
- Our positivity rate is at 35%. This means infection is rampant in our communities. Fifty eight community members died last week and 52 the week before.
- Unfortunately, these will not be the last of our community members affected. If no further actions are taken to get this virus under control, we may:
 - lose hundreds more friends and family in our communities this year.
 - face hospitals at capacity with unsustainable care needs.
 - hit more economic set backs.
 - and, give this virus more traction for the future a sit lingers out in our communities.
