RE: Conduct Citizen Participation Public Hearing on Winnebago County's CDBG-Close Project (Public

Hearing #2).

Background:

Approximately 20 years ago, Winnebago County was the recipient of Community Development Block Grant – Economic Development (CDBG-ED) Funding from the Wisconsin Department of Administration (WisDOA) Division of Energy, Housing and Community Resources (DEHCR), and Federal Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The funds were provided to the County for the purposes of funding business and industrial projects in the County that provided job opportunities for low-and-moderate income individuals. The program required the County to establish a low interest Revolving Loan fund for eligible businesses in the County. Because of its mission, the CDBG-ED funding was allocated to and managed by the County Industrial Development Board (IDB). Over the years the IDB's CDBG Revolving Loan Fund grew to approximately \$940,000. However, due to the stringent criteria for use of the funds established by HUD and WisDOA, only a small number of businesses qualified for loans from the program leaving a significant portion of the funds unused. This was also happening in many other communities throughout the state. This led the state to decide in 2019 to petition HUD to "close out" the program in the State of Wisconsin. HUD granted the state's request to close-out the program effective February 1, 2019. HUD also allowed the state and its local revolving loan programs, including Winnebago County, the opportunity to expend its available on hand loan funds for a one-time project within a 2-year period, provided the project was located in the unincorporated area of the County and located within a Low-and-Moderate Income census tract. After study and review, it was determined that Winnebago County was able to utilize its available funds for reconstruction of a one-mile segment of County Road Y between I-41 and County Road T in the Town of Oshkosh, saving the County from having to expend its own dollars for the roadway project. The roadway project was budgeted at \$807,000. On August 4, 2020, the Winnebago County Board adopted a resolution authorizing the Winnebago County Industrial Development Board to apply for the CDBG funding from the WisDOA. The IDB subsequently made application to the WisDOA for this project and they approved of the application for the project. Furthermore, WisDOA and HUD agreed to allow the remaining balance (approximately \$130,000) to be allocated to the City of Omro for an already planned and applied for wellhouse and well water system infrastructure project located in a low-and-moderate Income area of the City of Omro. Also, to manage the complex application process and ongoing project reporting requirements, the Winnebago County IDB retained Mid State Associates (MSA) to manage and administer the project for the County.

Policy Discussion:

HUD requires Winnebago County to conduct two Public Hearings on the status of the project as part of its required ongoing project reporting. The first Public Hearing was conducted by the Winnebago

County IDB at its meeting on July 23, 2020. The County Road Y project has now reached a point where it is necessary to conduct the required 2nd Public Hearing for the public's benefit. A notification was published in the Oshkosh Northwestern on February 9, 2022 to inform the public that the County IDB is conducting a public hearing on the project for Friday, February 25, 2022 at 10:30 am. The hearing notification will allow the public to participate in the meeting in person or virtually. MSA Consulting will report on the project during the hearing. The hearing will include an update on the status of the County's CDBG project, project activities to date, and activities yet to be completed. In addition, the public will be offered an opportunity to provide input on the CDBG project activities.

Requested Action:

No action will be taken by the IDB. This also is not a County Board item.

Committee Action:

No action will be taken by the IDB.
