11	Dispatchers bargaining units no longer have certified bargaining representatives; and

13	markets, the need to attract and retain qualified employees, and the desirability of treating those employees formerly	
14	represented in collective bargaining units on an equitable basis in as similar a manner as is feasible when compared	
15	with managerial, supervisory, and administrative employees; and	
16	WHEREAS, your undersigned Committee recommends the adjustments set forth above as well as a desire	
17	to restrain increases in the Winnebago County Budget and to act in a fiscally prudent manner.	
18 19	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors that it hereby	
20	authorizes the pay schedules for employees working in the Courthouse, Human Services Department, Park View	
21	Health Center, and Highway Department, as well as Bridgetenders and Professional Dispatchers, to be amended so	
22	as to increase the wages of covered employees having continuing satisfactory job performance by 1.75%, across-	
23	the-board, effective January 1, 2014

25	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors that it hereby authorizes an	
26	additional increase in wages of 1.5% (for a combined total increase of 3.25%) effective January 1, 2014, for any	
27	employee covered by the pay schedules for Courthouse, Human Services Department, Park View Health Center,	
28	and Highway Department employees, as well as for Bridgetenders and Professional Dispatchers, having continuing	
29	satisfactory job per	formances and whose pay has not yet reached the midpoint of the applicable pay scale.
30 31	BE IT FUR	THER RESOLVED by the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors that any employee who
32	received a step inc	rease between January 1, 2014, and February 10, 2014 (the date on which any further step
33	increases were suspended) will receive the larger of (a) the pay increase provided by this Resolution; or (b) the step	
34	increase already received, but not both, and that step increases under the pay schedules covered by this Resolution	
35	will be frozen as of February 10, 2014.
