46	(1) Where the sign is proposed to be located
47	(highway/location);
48	(2) The direction of traffic in which the sign shall face;
49	(3) The sign offset (distance from edge of right-of-way to
50	travel lane);
51	(4) The type of post requested to be used;
52	(5) Written assurance from the local unit of government that
53	the sign will be free-standing (not attached to other
54	signs);
55	(6) A written copy of the local government noise ordinance.

57	(3) Upon submission of such a request, the Winnebago County
58	Highway Commissioner shall issue a permit for the installation
59	of such a sign within thirty (30) days of submission of said
60	application or shall issue a written denial of said application,
61	stating the reasons for the denial of such a permit.

63	(4) Upon issuance of a permit, the local unit of government shall be
64	responsible for installing and maintaining the sign in
65	conformance with the permit. The local unit of government may
66	contract with the Winnebago County Highway Department for
67	the construction, installation and maintenance of such a sign.
68	
69	(5) It shall be the responsibility of the local unit of government to
70	enforce its own noise ordinances in relationship to the "no
71	engine braking" sign.
72	
73	(6) A standard sign, reading "No Engine Braking Except in
74	Emergency" may be permitted at or near the corporate limits of
75	a local community. The preferred location for placement of such
76	a sign must be in the proximity of any signage notifying drivers
77	of reduced speed ahead, but shall not be within 200 feet of any
78	existing highway signage.
79	
80	(7) An optional sign, stating, "No Engine Braking Except in
81	Emergency Within City/Village/Town Limits" may be permitted
82	by the Highway Commissioner to supplement other signs if
83	there are perceived problems with enforcement of engine
84	braking on roadways throughout a community. All sign
85	language shall meet the requirements of the Wisconsin
86	Department of Transportation.
87	· ·
88	(8) All other engine braking signs previously installed on
89	Winnebago County Trunk Highways shall be amended to
90	conform to this ordinance no later than January 1, 2012 or shall
91	be removed.

93	(9) That this Ordinance shall take effect as of June 1, 2011.
