The following variance was acted on:

I. <u>Lynn T. MacDonald – Town of Neenah</u>

The variance requested to keep a patio, sidewalk, and fire pit with a substandard shore yard setback.

A motion was made by T. Verstegen to deny the variance. Motion seconded by G. Kargus.

Findings:

- 1. Exceptional Circumstances: None.
- 2. <u>Preservation of Property Rights:</u> The property owners will maintain reasonable use of the property without the granting of a variance for the patio, sidewalk, and fire pit. The structures in questions are a personal convenience, not a necessity.
- Absence of Detriment: The property owners currently have reasonable use of this property, and granting a variance would result in a special privilege not enjoyed by other owners of similar properties.

Based upon the above findings, it is the opinion of the Board that all criteria of Section 17.32(7)(a), (b), and (c) have not been met.
