D. Mingus read the legal description and requested variance for the following agenda item:

Robert Kinderman - Town of Clayton

Robert Kinderman appeared. He is requesting the variance in order to tear down the existing detached, dilapidated, nonconforming garage and replace it with a 22' x 36' attached garage. The new garage will improve the shore yard setback by 14 ft, having a 53 ft setback from the ordinary high water mark of the stream. Kinderman also stated that he was improving the buffer between the residence/garage and stream by letting the natural vegetation grow versus mowing it to grass as had been done previously.

There was some discussion between board members, C. Zeinert, and Mr. Kinderman about the setback distance (where it was measured from) and the previous variance that was granted for a residential addition.

C. Zeinert read the resolution submitted by the Town of Clayton recommending approval with conditions.

There being no other business, Chairman Schroeder adjourned the meeting at 5:43 p.m.
